REPORT of IIC Activities - IIC 4.0 Quarter 1 & 2


1. Motivational session by Mr. Dinoj Joseph, Entrepreneur and Start up founder, MD MEDGYOR PVT. LTD.




3. Webinar on IPR awareness programme for NIPAM organized


